It is my pleasure to announce the XXII International Symposium of Bioluminescence and Chemiluminescence (ISBC) and the XX International Symposium of Luminescence Spectroscopy (ISLS) as a joint meeting to be held from June 3d to 7th 2024, in Foz do Iguaçu, PR, Brazil, near the stunning Iguaçú Falls, a UNESCO natural heritage site and a biodiversity hotspot. During the ISBC last event, in Gijón, Spain, Brazil was selected to host the next event in 2024, due to the strategic importance of this large growing economy, with its rich biodiversity of bioluminescent organisms which has fostered several discoveries and the generation of new biotechnological applications in the biomedical and environmental areas in recent decades. The event will be held in conjunction with the International Symposium on Luminescence Spectroscopy (ISLS), which has a large community in South America. We expect a large and exciting multidisciplinary event that will substantially contribute to the dissemination of the most recent scientific technological in bioluminescence, and advances chemiluminescence and photoluminescence, and will also contribute to sustainable development, through the dissemination of the many applications of luminescence for bioindication, biosensing and bioimaging in medicine, environment and industry. The event is expected to have around 400 or more participants from Brazil and around the world, who will participate in the two simultaneous events.
